Can you read any of the words? See if you can find the words from your 'word books' in the text. Can you sort these into 'Heavy' and 'Light'?</p> <p>Do you think you can then order them from the heaviest to the lightest</p> <p>Does your grown up agree?</p> <p>Can you draw or write a list</p>	<p><u>Spring Time</u></p> <p>Spring has arrived and we have been lucky to have had some sunshine as well. Can you notice any changes? What looks different? From your windows or gardens what can you see? Can you draw or write about the changes you have spotted?</p> <p>Maybe we can all draw a picture of what we can see from</p>	<p><u>Play Board Games</u></p> <p>Play a board game. Do you have a favourite? Make sure you follow the rules and no cheating.</p> <p>Maybe you can make up a list of rules or instructions for when other people want to play?</p> <p>Can you design and make up your own game?</p>	<p><u>Who's the Teacher ?</u></p> <p>We are really missing teaching you Read Write Inc... so your challenge is to teach your grown ups or your toys the sounds you know.
