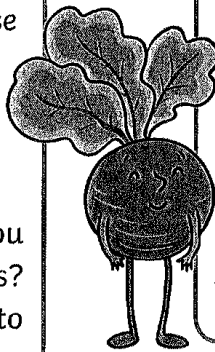


Carrot Club

Home Learning Challenges

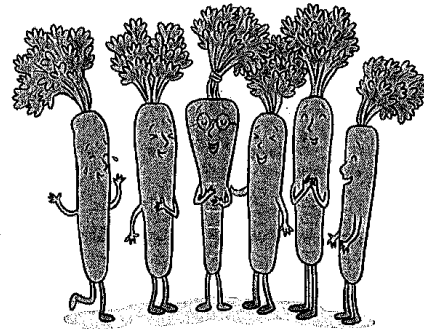
There are lots of different vegetable characters in the story, 'Carrot Club'. What is your favourite vegetable? Ask some of your family and friends about their favourite vegetables. Are their favourites the same as yours?

Make some models of different vegetables. You could use playdough, salt dough, building bricks or empty packaging. Can you make a carrot, a sprout and a potato? What colours do you need to decorate your models? You could bring in a model to show your friends!



There were 6 carrots inside the 'Carrot Club'. If 1 more carrot entered the club, how many carrots would there be inside the club altogether? Try using your fingers or drawing a picture to help you count.

Visit a fruit and vegetable shop or supermarket with a grown-up. What different vegetables can you see? Can you find some of the vegetables from the story? Try to find carrots, sprouts, parsnips, beetroot, broccoli and onions.



Ask a grown-up to help you plant some vegetables to grow. You could plant some cress seeds in an empty yoghurt pot, some beans in a plastic cup or plant some carrots in an allotment or garden.

Write a shopping list of vegetables. You could write a list of your favourite vegetables or the vegetables seen in the story – there are some pictures on this page to help you!

Try to sound out each word and write all the letter sounds you can hear.
