Adventure

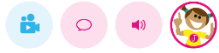
The adventure acts as a warm up and encourages children to move in different ways. All the movements will relate to the topic.

Each topic has a song that children can learn. The music can be found on the toolbar that is at the top right hand side of the screen.



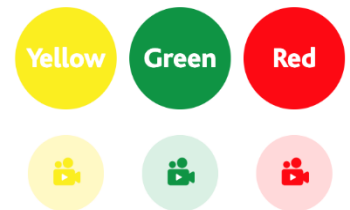
Story
