- Tests are not timed and are usually administered in small groups
- All completed by Half Term
- Tests are marked and scaled. Children are judged to be working towards the expected level, met the expected standard or Greater Depth.
- External Moderation
- Data sent to the Local Authority/Department for Education by the end of June.

- Across MAT (Leigh Beck and Northwick Park).
