Please help your child to learn these key maths facts and practise these key skills. Show any evidence of practise in this folder. If you are excited to show your teacher your hard work please bring it in, I would love to see it! I will assess these skills in lessons and update the maths homework accordingly every half term.

Recognise and order numbers to 20- Can you go further?
Count forwards and backwards to 20 - Can you go further? - Could practise this by counting cars on the way to school, counting their toys etc.
Making amounts- Can you make amounts using objects such as marbles, sweets etc?
Count one more and one less - using toys, marbles etc.
Compare groups of objects - greater than, less than and equal to (Numbers to 20).

These are some of the skills we will working on in class throughout this half term.
