You already know that our topic for this half term is Rivers and Bridges. Here are a few more ideas to progress your learning of this topic.

1. Research, learn about and understand the different parts and features of rivers. <http://www.primaryhomeworkhelp.co.uk/rivers/stages.html> is a very good website to use to support you with this. You might learn about the upper, middle and lower courses of rivers as well as features such as sources, mouths and meanders. Create a glossary of any new words you have learnt with their meanings.
2. Use your new understanding of rivers to sketch or create your own river. It is entirely your decision how you present this based on what resources you have at home but make sure the features of your river are clearly labelled please.
