

Optional Extension Activities for Reception

Dear Reception Pupils,

Well done for completing your daily work through Purple Mash and we hope you are enjoying the work set. Below you will find the next set of challenges that are optional for the next two weeks, you can do some or all of it if you wish. You can hand it in the usual ways to your teachers.

- Following on from our work on the 'time' can you make your own daily timetable? Maybe you could look at the clock and see what time you do certain things? Record what you do in the mornings and the afternoons? You could include your evening routine as well.
- Now you understand how to measure different things by length can you see how many steps long your front room/bed room is? Which room is the longest/shortest? How could you record your findings?
- Can you arrange a pretend tea party for your toys? Think about what you have learnt about adding and subtraction? Some of your toys may bring food but some may eat lots. You could pretend a hungry dragon comes and eats some of the food? How could you record your answers?
Eg There are 10 toys and only 8 cakes. How many more cakes do you need?
- Can you draw something to go with every letter of the alphabet? Eg a for anchor, b for banana etc
- Read your favourite story to your teddies or grown up? Remember to look at the sounds to help you read and use the pictures to help you. Can you draw a picture of your favourite character and say why you have chosen them?
- Can you draw or write to a friend or someone who you miss from school? Ask your grown up to email them to us and we will try our best to share it with them for you. Don't forget to tell us who it is for on the email.
